NOTES

1. **Annual Inspection:** Annual inspection is scheduled for this drill. This is a mandatory drill for all hands. The personnel inspection will be conducted for all cadets and officers in dress uniforms, so make sure you have a plastic name tag and all ribbons, insignia and shoulder flashes.
2. **MTVR Simulator (March 13, 2010):** During our March 13 drill we will be training in the MTVR (Medium Tactical Vehicle Replacement) simulator. The MTVR is a 7-ton, is a six-wheel drive all-terrain vehicle used by the United States Marine Corps and United States Navy. The MTVR is the Marine Corps prime mover for the M777 howitzer, fuel and water assets, troops and a wide variety of equipment. Its wide versatility and off-road capability make the MTVR an integral part of the Marine Corps logistical backbone. Each cadet will have the opportunity to learn about the vehicle and drive the simulator.
3. **NLCC Flagship (March 26-28, 2010):** The Flagship competition for TS Nicholas H. Anderson will be held on Saturday, March 26-28, 2010 at JFTB Los Alamitos. Cost is \$25.00 per cadet and all Instructors and Officers escorting and attending the event will have their meals paid for and be provided berthing. We are hoping for full unit participation for this event.
4. **Seal Challenge (March 27, 2010):** The annual Seal Challenge is scheduled for March 27, 2010 at Naval Air Station Lemoore. 2. The competition is based on the Navy Seal Physical Readiness Test. There will be 25 teams of 5 cadets each, with teams being graded on their overall scores as a team. Each competitor will be scored on their ability to perform each event. Anyone interested should confirm immediately with LPO Wagner.
5. **NSCC Study Requirements:** All NSCC cadets are reminded that they are required to submit at least two completed BMR or Seaman Assignments between each drill. This is a requirement for promotion, participation in any advanced training, and retention in the program. In addition, remember that you cannot be promoted without a qualified advanced training to match your study guides. Too many cadets are way behind in meeting these requirements.

When submitting assignments, all cadets are to follow the procedure specified by the training officer.
6. **ID Card Expiration (March - April 2010):** Renewals need to be requested from ENS Wagner now. This is a requirement for annual inspection.
7. **Recruiting:** All hands are tasked to recruit new cadets and staff for the unit. Remember the recruiting incentive: recruiting three cadets will earn a FREE training for you.
8. **Use the Chain of Command:** If you will be absent or late, please contact your respective LPO or Division Officer.
9. **Military Courtesy:** Remember to render proper salutes and courtesies to all officers and instructors when on the base.

NOTE: I have received several reports of cadets cursing and disrespecting the cadet leadership while at drill. This will not be tolerated and will result in immediate disciplinary action, up to and including dismissal from the program.
10. **Unit Spaces:** All cadets and staff are to enter the building through the rear stairs. Quarterdeck etiquette is to be observed by all members whenever watch is open.
11. **Haircuts (males):** Make sure your hair meets Navy and NSCC regulations. No excuses or exceptions.
12. **Hair (females):** Hair must be styled to stay above the collar at all times when in uniform.

13. **Sweepers**: Make sure to double-check ALL areas for trash and other items. No personnel will be dismissed until spaces have been checked and cleared.
14. **Unit Website**: Calendar on website (www.benmoreellbattalion.org) has been updated to include 2010 drill schedule, upcoming summer trainings, and other useful information. Please check the website on a regular basis.
15. **Naval History**: On this date in 1942, in the Battle of the Java Sea, Allied Naval Force attacks Japanese invasion convoy.
16. **Staff Meeting**: There is a staff meeting scheduled for Sunday, 11 APR 10, at 09:00 at the drill site.
