**NOTES**

1. **Welcome Aboard:** The following cadets came aboard during December 2011:
  
2. **NSCC Study Requirements:** All NSCC cadets are reminded that they are required to submit at least two completed BMR or Seaman Assignments between each drill. This is a requirement for promotion, participation in any advanced training, and retention in the program. In addition, remember that you cannot be promoted without a qualified advanced training to match your study guides. Too many cadets remain way behind in meeting these requirements.
3. **ID Card Expiration (December 2011 – February 2011):** Renewals need to be requested from LTJG Wagner now. This is a requirement for participating in drill and any other NSCC or NLCC training. NOTE: You cannot attend any training without a current ID card.
  
4. **Recruiting:** All hands are tasked to recruit new cadets and staff for the unit. Remember the recruiting incentive: recruiting three cadets will earn a FREE training for you.
5. **Use the Chain of Command:** If you will be absent or late, please contact your respective LPO or Division Officer.
6. **Military Courtesy:** Remember to render proper salutes and courtesies to all officers and instructors when on the base.
7. **Unit Spaces:** All cadets and staff are to enter the building through the rear stairs. Quarterdeck etiquette is to be observed by all members whenever watch is open.
8. **Haircuts (males):** Make sure your hair meets Navy and NSCC regulations. No excuses or exceptions.
9. **Hair (females):** Hair must be styled to stay above the collar at all times when in uniform.
10. **Sweepers:** Make sure to double-check ALL areas for trash and other items. No personnel will be dismissed until spaces have been checked and cleared.
